

LEGAL LIABILITY, RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The decision of the Judges is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse any entry without stating a reason
2. Entry fees can only be refunded after the closing date on production of a medical or Veterinary Certificate.
3. Legal Liability - Neither the organisers, employees or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, rider, spectators, land, cars/vehicles, their contents and accessories any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any way whatsoever.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times when mounted
5. A protective helmet to current safety standards must be worn at all times while mounted.
6. All ridden horses must be aged 4 and over
7. All dogs must be kept on their leads at all times.
8. Any person wishing to lodge an objection to the secretary should submit it in writing within 15 minutes of the result with a £20 deposit which will be retained if the objection is overruled.
9. It is the responsibility of the competitor to contact the organiser to check for cancellation due to adverse weather conditions. For up to date information www.toomerfarm.com
10. It is the responsibility of the competitor when entering to ensure they do not enter classes that may clash
11. No competitor shall enter the show ring once the class has commenced judging unless the judge advises otherwise
12. The judge may amalgamate or
13. Health and Safety - The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the rules and instructions of the organisers and stewards/officials.

Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk>
